In **red** are the programs that need/want volunteers, in **bold black** states if the consumers have mental illness or retardation, and are either children or adults, than in **green** is the possible time to volunteer, **below each one** is a short summary/ description for the volunteers to understand their duties. Child Development and Training (CD&T) Children M-F 8:30-4:30

- Provides child care and developmental stimulation to children age 0-22 with or without disabilities.
- Hold/ Rock babies, read to children. Take on playground/field trips/ Help with art projects.

Early Childhood Intervention (ECI) Infants M-F 8:30-4:30

- A therapeutic program for infants who have developmental disabilities
- Age 0-3, assistance and other services for children living in Anderson, Cherokee, Henderson, Rains, Smith, Van Zandt, and Wood counties

Tutoring at the Andrews Center MI Children Tues. & Thurs. 5-7

- Helps children who are behind in school.
- Work one-on-one with children on school work.

Texas Correctional Office on Offenders with Medical and Mental Impairments (TCOOMI)

Adults M-F 8-5

- Provide services for mentally impaired offenders on probation, parole or incarcerated.
- Assist Jail Diversion Counselor, diagnosis coding, go to jail observe assist with evaluations, assist with office functions: imaging, filing, shredding, phone, faxing information to jails, attorney.

Andrews Diversified Industries (ADI) MR Adults M-F 8-3

- Provides people with disabilities valuable skills training, manufacturing experience and for some, the chance to work on a mobile work crew

Lobby Monitor at the Andrews Center MR/MI Children/Adults M-F 8-5

- Provide help for children and adults with mental illness and mental retardation
- Assist with reading form and writing, playing with children, communicate with a client, hand out magazines...

Group Homes MR Adults/Children All week

- Help with shopping, training with life skills, hang out, playing games, and make conversation. Just being a buddy to the clients!

Pharmacy/Nurse Clinic Adults/Children M-F 8-5

- Assist pharmacist and nurse

Respite Medically Fragile/Developmentally Delayed Children Every 3rd Sat 10-4

- Parent's day out program. 3 months to 18 years.
- Do craft and play with children. Group can plan a day out.
