Fall 2022 Undergraduates

- Total Undergraduates: 6,594 (not including dual credit and post-bac students)
- New FTIC Students: 1,124
 - Largest FTIC Cohort (3rd year in a row)
 - Full-Time FTIC Cohort: 1,015
 - CAP: 109 (not full-time this year)

• Fall 2021 Non CAP Retention: 73.38% (lowest in 2 years)





Retention Goals

- For our 2022-2023 cohort, retain at least 83% (843 of the 1,015 FT FTIC students) of full-time FTIC students.
 - If each department had their best retention rate since 2017, we would have an 86% retention rate. **This is an achievable goal.**



By improving by small increments each year, we can retain 90% of our FTIC students by 2027–2028.



Retention: A Daily Issue for Faculty

- Learning environment is engaging and supportive
- Class experiences promote learning and have value, provide opportunities to practice and get feedback on learning
- Course structure is organized to promote student behavior leading to academic success
- Assessment is purposefully implemented to allow for students to continuously improve and is timely
- With timely feedback to students and Academic Success, students, advisors, and other academic success personnel can support students.




Enrollment by Career






Fall-to-Spring FTIC Retention
