CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT – UT TYLER IS MY HOME SCHOOL

- Concurrent enrollment is a way to receive the entire amount of Pell Grant a student is eligible for based upon the number of hours he or she is enrolled in at UT Tyler and a local community college.
- Students may only receive financial aid from one school per semester.
- Students must take this Concurrent Enrollment Form from to the local community college's financial aid office.
- The increase will be put into your UT Tyler account after the census day when enrollment can be verified.
- Remaining funds will be disbursed according to the dates posted in the UT Tyler Financial Aid Handbook.
- The increase of the Pell Grant **WILL NOT** be sent to the local community college for payment. **THE STUDENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING THE OTHER COLLEGE BY THEIR POSTED PAYMENT DEADLINE.**
- STUDENT MUST ALSO HAVE AN APPROVED TRANSIENT FORM ON FILE WITH REGISTRAR'S OFFICE FOR THE SEMESTER REQUESTING FINANCIAL AID.
