## **COURSE DESCRIPTION AND LEARNING OBJECTIVES**

An assessment of competencies at the piano keyboard commensurate with advanced musical study and professional expectations. Skills assessed include sightreading, accompanying skills, and theory applications including lead sheets, figured bass and harmonic progressions. Prerequisites include Muap 2111 Harmony & Keyboard III or 3 semesters of either class piano or applied piano.

## **GRADES**

Students who successfully complete all parts of the assessment will receive a grade of CR (Credit). Students may retake any portions of the exam until a passing grade is reached. Students not completing all portions of the exam within the semester enrolled will receive a grade of NC (No Credit) and must retake the course.

## **COURSE MATERIALS AND REQUIREMENTS**

Review classes will be offered for transfer students at the beginning of fall and spring semesters. Students may also receive individual help in preparing for the assessment by contacting the instructor during office hours or by requesting an appointment.

Students concurrently enrolled in Harmony & Keyboard IV will take the assessment at the scheduled final exam time. Transfer students may schedule an assessment date and time with the instructor at any time during the semester.
