

The College of Education and Psychology has a leadership philosophy of CCR: capacity, connection, and responsiveness. This is not just for general leadership. The responsibility we have for scholarship and research is embedded within this philosophy.

First, developing a greater understanding of the vital issues of our time helps build capacity both within the individual and discipline. An example is the work of the MARC on dementia. The center consistently adds capacity to the profession through publications that delve deeper into this important topic, and it is on the cutting edge in using virtual reality for diagnosis. Furthermore, the center builds capacity in students by getting them involved in the research, as well.

Getting students involved in research is something many of our faculty do, and it increases the connection our students feel to their work. Students remember their first poster presentation and publication, and along with connecting better with professors, it increases their connection to UT Tyler. This often creates lifelong learners who continue to be responsive to the needs of society.

This responsiveness is important, as each discipline has challenges that need to be addressed. For example, faculty in the College of Education and Psychology are working on increasing the socio-emotional learning of students in response to the bullying and violence epidemic we have observed in our schools. Determining ways in which socio-emotional learning can help make for safer schools is just one way the college is responsive to current needs.

Scholarship is an important component of the professional life of professors in the College of Education and Psychology. Embedded within it is the leadership components of CCR: Building capacity, increasing connection, and being responsive. The publications of 2019 helped add to our knowledge of psychology, counseling, and education in important ways.

Boyer's famous definition of scholarship includes aspects encompassing discovery, integration, application and teaching/learning. The engineering and construction management disciplines stand atop a knowledge base built upon information discovered, created and integrated across these four areas, and the College of Engineering at UT Tyler is part of a nationwide engine that continues to add to this knowledge base.

The professions of engineering and construction management are transformative endeavors that leverage creativity, critical thinking, technical skills, math and science, leadership, and ethical practices to innovate solutions for complex problems. Our faculty is composed of highly engaged individuals dedicated to student success, research excellence, and the advancement of their discipline. The College as a whole is productive across these four areas of scholarship – below, a few examples are highlighted.

In the discovery area, examples this year include Dr. Saygili's (Civil Engineering) work in exploring the seismic performance of earth slopes during earthquake, Dr. Khajah's (Mechanical Engineering) efforts in developing novel methods of finite element analysis for optimization across numerous fields including acoustics, materials design and shape selection, and Dr. Indic's (Electrical Engineering) contributions in the study of the impacts of supplemental oxygen in preterm infants.

The scholarship of discovery is a natural fit in the College of Engineering. Dr. Vechione (Civil Engineering) is applying transportation operations techniques to impact the mobility of seniors, while Dr. Souliman (Civil Engineering) has developed and is beginning to implement a hub-and-spoke bicycle lane engineered scoring system to impact this transportation mode. A further example involves Dr. Sundaravadivel (Electrical Engineering) who is applying IOT theory and process to problems such as smart metering of energy, residential water usage and detection of oil leaks.

In the area of integration, Dr. Chou (Mechanical Engineering) is using engineering approaches to explore health issues such as blood clotting and medical decontamination. Dr. Biswas (Mechanical Engineering) has provided a review of solid oxide electrolyzer cell modeling of dry carbon dioxide electrolysis, and Dr. Shirvaikar (Electrical Engineering) is integrating Image processing techniques into the field of crop management.

Teaching and learning of engineering and construction management concepts, principles and pedagogy is one of the core areas of the college. Dr. Gangone (Civil Engineering) provided insights into ethical dilemmas faced by engineering design teams and also the ways that students can contribute to hiring engineering faculty. Dr. Fumo (Mechanical Engineering) has provided examples of how to incorporate higher learning experiences in teaching fluid mechanics. Professor Boylan (Construction Management) published work on the organization and impact of a leadership and ethics training workshop for students. Dr. Goh (Mechanical Engineering) also made contributions in the area of leadership and character development of engineering students.



The College of Nursing and Health Sciences (CNHS) offers a variety of health related undergraduate and graduate programs at UT Tyler. The CNHS enrollment continues to be healthy with 2,555 students in Fall 2019. Our student success initiatives achieved a retention rate of 92 percent for all first-time freshmen. Furthermore, the faculty in CNHS continues to be excellent in scholarship and creativity. Our faculty have published 60 peer-reviewed journal papers, seven book chapters, and made 61 professional presentations at international, national, or regional conferences.

The CNHS currently houses the School of Nursing, Department of Health and Kinesiology, and Institute for Integrated Healthcare.

The School of Nursing has a very competitive nursing BSN program with a 95 percent pass rate on the national license exam. MSN Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP) students had a pass rate of 100 percent on the national certification exam. Our RN-BSN online program was ranked #1 in Texas https://www.registerednursing.org/rn-to-bsn/texas/#program-rankings, and ranked top 25 in the nation https://www.registerednursing.org/rn-tobsn/#program-rankings, by the Registered Nurse Organization in 2019. We are also adding two new nursing graduate programs: MSN in Informatics and MSN in Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP). Dr. Carol Rizer, Associate Professor of Nursing, was awarded \$2.8 million from Health Resources & Service Administration (HRSA) to provide immersive clinical traineeships in rural/medical underserved areas for primary care nursing practitioner and PMHNP students. In addition, Dr. Cathy Miller, Associate Professor of Nursing, was awarded \$450,000 from the Department of Justice to design programs that offer mentoring and support services to victims of commercial sexual exploitation and domestic sex trafficking. In total, the faculty in the School of Nursing have obtained more than \$3 million in federal grants

The faculty in the Department of Health and Kinesiology continue their excellence in teaching and research activities. The overall graduate enrollment for Health and Kinesiology was up 21 percent. The Master of Occupational Therapy (MOT) program continued to grow increasing enrollment to 41 students. The Communication Sciences and Disorders (CSD) BS program had the first cohort of 24 students. The creation of a FitSteps for Life exercise center has provided individualized and structured exercise treatment specifically for patients with cancer and other chronic diseases. Dr. Cheryl Cooper, Associate Professor of Health Sciences, was awarded a research grant of \$103,976 from the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health to investigate contributing factors on slips, trips and falls among Texas shrimp fishermen.

The Institute of Integrated Healthcare (IIH) received first donation from Project Rose Research Institute for Sports Science to conduct research in anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) rehabilitation. The IIH continued to support faculty research, to involve students in research, and to promote community health by providing Tai Chi mind-body exercises to local seniors and offering vaccine clinics for HPV.

In summary, the CNHS leadership team, faculty and staff continue to work diligently to promote student success and faculty scholar productivity, and to pursue external grant funding.



The Ben and Maytee Fisch College of Pharmacy was established in fall 2013 with the mission to advance the public health and wellness of the citizens of East Texas and beyond through innovation and collaboration in pharmacy, education, scholarship, and advocacy. In fall 2015, we enrolled our pioneer class of students. Those students graduated in spring 2019, entering the profession as pharmacists well-founded in the knowledge and skills needed to establish meaningful careers in healthcare.

Fisch College of Pharmacy students learn in a progressively integrated teambased program built on fundamental scaffolding. The innovative pedagogy emphasizes communication, critical thinking, and teamwork to solve realworld problems facing patients and practitioners today.

Beginning the first semester in the program, Fisch College of Pharmacy students spend nearly 2,000 hours outside the classroom in the community working alongside pharmacists, nurses, and physicians to provide care for patients in the community and in the hospital. Over 700 practicing pharmacists have worked with our student pharmacists at nearly 600 practice sites in Texas. Our students' are building a positive reputation throughout the state.

Two departments are the academic components of the Fisch College of Pharmacy. The Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences is chaired by Dr. Rahmat Talukder and consists of eight faculty members with scholarship interests ranging from the discovery of new drugs to treat cancer to using virtual reality to augment team-based learning. The Clinical Sciences Department is chaired by Dr. Brad Brazill and consists of 20 pharmacist faculty who have varied areas of practice specialty meeting the needs of students and patients in East Texas. Scholarship interests include health literacy, drug development, cancer treatment, substance misuse, transitions of care, and a host of other topics.



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
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
