Course Objectives:

The student will demonstrate their ability to perform a 30-minute recital program that will fulfill their Junior Recital requirement for Performance Majors and Music Education Majors.

Required materials

- Jury form
- All repertoire that will be performed must be purchased

Course Requirements

- Preparation and successful public performance of repertoire selections in consultation with instructor representing a variety of styles from Classical through Contemporary periods
- The student will be responsible for creating and writing program notes to represent at the recital hearing and submitting program information to the music office 2 weeks prior to the recital date
- The recital performance should showcase the students ability to communicate with an audience using refined technical and musical skills and an understanding of stylistic and historical periods of music

Attendance Policy

Attendance is mandatory for a pre-recital hearing one month in advance, a dress rehearsal, and the scheduled performance.

Evaluation and Grading:

Credit or No Credit = Pass/Fail

The course grade is the majority of votes assigned by 3 faculty committee membersat the conclusion of the recital performance.
