Course Description

The instruction in this course is geared toward music major gaining feel a basic level of comfort of playing, teaching, and maintaining low brass instruments.

Student Learning Outcomes

At the completion of this course student will:

- Be able to perform at an entry live to play along with future beginners on low brass instruments.
- Have a basic understand of brass pedagogy to help students work through common issues at the intermediate level.
- Have a basic understand of the set-up, maintenance, and care needed to have a properly working instrument. Especially important for beginners.
- Have a solid understanding of fundamental brass playing procedures like posture, breathing, harmonic series, tone, slide coordination, articulation, and vibrato.
