

Henderson County Economic Overview 2024

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Demographic Profile

The population in Henderson County, Texas was 82,627 per American Community Survey data for 2018-2022. The region has a civilian labor force of 35,626 with a participation rate of 53.2%. Of individuals 25 to 64 in Henderson County, Texas, 17.7% have a bachelor's degree or higher which compares with 35.8% in the nation. The median household income in Henderson County, Texas is \$59,778 and the median house value is \$159,600.



About This Report

Unemployment Rate

The unemployment rate for Henderson County, Texas was 4.3% as of February 2024. The regional unemployment rate was higher than the national rate of 4.2%. One year earlier, in February 2023, the unemployment rate in Henderson County, Texas was 5.2%.




Unemployment Rate for Henderson County, Texas

Wage Trends

The average worker in Henderson County, Texas earned annual wages of \$43,090 as of 2023Q4. Average annual wages per worker increased 4.6% in the region over the preceding four quarters. For comparison purposes, annual average wages were \$69,861 in the nation as of 2023Q4.

About This Report

Cost of Living Index

The Cost of Living Index estimates the relative price levels for consumer goods and services. When applied to wages and salaries, the result is a measure of relative purchasing power. The cost of living is 8.2% lower in Henderson County, Texas than the U.S. average.

About This Report

Occupation Snapshot

The largest major occupation group in Henderson County, Texas is Management Occupations, employing 2,416 workers. The next-largest occupation groups in the region are Office and Administrative Support Occupations (2,409 workers) and Food Preparation and Serving Related Occupations (2,368). High location quotients (LQs) indicate occupation groups in which a region has high concentrations of employment compared to the national average. The major groups with the largest LQs in the region are Construction and Extraction Occupations (LQ = 1.59), Management Occupations (1.38), and Production Occupations (1.36).

Occupation groups in Henderson County, Texas with the highest average wages per worker are Legal Occupations (\$104,200), Management Occupations (\$88,300), and Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations (\$88,100). The unemployment rate in the region varied among the major groups from 1.0% among Legal Occupations to 6.3% among Food Preparation and Serving Related Occupations.

Over the next 1 year, the fastest growing occupation group in Henderson County, Texas is expected to be Healthcare Support Occupations with a +2.8% year-over-year rate of growth. The strongest forecast by number of jobs over this period is expected for Management Occupations (+38 jobs) and Food Preparation and Serving Related Occupations (+38). Over the same period, the highest separation demand (occupation demand due to retirements and workers moving from one occupation to another) is expected in Food Preparation and Serving Related Occupations (480 jobs) and Sales and Related Occupations (331).



Wages by occupation are as of 2023 provided by the BLS and imputed where necessary. Forecast employment growth uses national projections from the Bureau of Labor Statistics adapted for regional growth patterns.

About This Report

Industry Clusters

A cluster is a geographic concentration of interrelated industries or occupations. The industry cluster in Henderson County, Texas with the highest relative concentration is Textile/Leather with a location quotient of 3.61. This cluster employs 172 workers in the region with an average wage of \$32,682. Employment in the Textile/Leather cluster is projected to expand in the region about 0.4% per year over the next ten years.

About This Report

Education Levels

Expected growth rates for occupations vary by the education and training required. While all employment in Henderson County, Texas is projected to grow 1.6% over the next ten years, occupations typically requiring a postgraduate degree are expected to grow 2.0% per year, those requiring a bachelor's degree are forecast to grow 1.9% per year, and occupations typically needing a 2-year degree or certificate are expected to grow 2.0% per year.




Annual Average Projected Job Growth by Education Levels

Gross Domestic Product

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is the total value of goods and services produced by a region. In 2022, nominal GDP in Henderson County, Texas expanded 11.2%. This follows growth of 9.6% in 2021. As of 2022, total GDP in Henderson County, Texas was \$2,152,321,000.

Of the sectors in Henderson County, Texas, Manufacturing contributed the largest portion of GDP in 2022, \$327,471,000 The next-largest contributions came from Retail Trade (\$239,745,000); Real Estate and Rental and Leasing (\$210,819,000); and Construction (\$202,086,000).
