Tests will be available on the Canvas (click "Assignments" on the course menu) only for the time allotted. The testing time per test is **90 minutes** and will present all questions at once. Note that you are allowed only **ONE attempt** per test so please make sure you study the course material and textbook thoroughly before you begin and can devote sufficient time to complete the test.

Please complete the test during the test period, and also note that **NO makeup tests** will be allowed except for documented emergencies (official evidence documents are required). See more details for Exam policy in the syllabus.

Test 1 (Chapter 1, Chapter 2, and Chapter 3) will be available on the Canvas from Sunday, January 30 noon to Thursday, February 3 midnight (Central Time), includes **25 multiple-choices questions** (15 conceptual questions and 10 numerical questions those are similar to the numerical questions shown in power point slides).

Test 2 (Chapter 4, Chapter 5, and Chapter 6) will be available on the Canvas from Sunday, February 27 noon to Thursday, March 3 midnight (Central Time), includes **25 multiple-choices questions** (15 conceptual questions and 10 numerical questions those are similar to the numerical questions shown in power point slides and Financial Calculator Tutorial).

Test 3 (Chapter 7, Chapter 8, Chapter 11) will be available on the Canvas from Sunday, April 3 noon to Thursday, April 7 midnight (Central Time), includes **25 multiple-choices questions** (15 conceptual questions and 10 numerical questions).

Test 4 (Chapter 13 and Chapter 14) (administered by ProctorU Auto*) will be available on the Canvas from Sunday, April 24 noon to Thursday, April 28 midnight (Central Time), includes **25 multiple-choices questions** (17 conceptual questions and 8 numerical questions).
