- Submit GRE scores (UT Tyler code is 6850). The GRE will be waived if your last 60 hours of coursework or your overall undergraduate GPA is a 3.25 or better. The GRE will also be waived if you have completed a master's degree with a 3.0 or better GPA.
- Submit [Student Information Sheet & Statement of Purpose](#).
- Submit 3 recommenders to complete a [Recommendation Form](#).
- **Final Step:** We will send you a link to schedule a Zoom interview.
