HNRS 2000 is a zero-credit course that is required for participation in the Honors College. This course is designed to allow students to get the most out of their experience in the Honors College during their time at UT Tyler. Students will arrange alternate meeting times and due dates with the Honors Coordinator.

Evaluation

Students will receive a grade of either “CR” (credit) or “NC” (no credit) for this course. Please keep in mind, as a zero-credit course, no credit hours are earned. **In order to receive the grade of CR for this course, students cannot miss more than one class meeting.** If you must miss more than one meeting, you must set up a time to meet with me outside of class. Additionally, students must earn a satisfactory evaluation on the following assignments:

- Seminar participation through Canvas
- Attendance at Seminar meetings
- Completion of all Canvas assignments
- Attendance at Honors Events

Students should check for their first assignment no later than Tuesday August 29.

Students who do not earn a grade of CR in an Honors Seminar will lose good standing in the Honors Program.
