

Help Improve Mental Health Care For Texas Children

The Texas Child Mental Health Care Consortium (TCMHCC) is recruiting research participants ages 8-20 years old who have experienced painful or stressful life events.

This can include a serious medical illness or injury, loss of a loved one, witnessing or experiencing violence, physical or emotional threats, a motor vehicle accident, natural disaster, animal attack, neglect, sexual assault, family separation, experiences of terrorism, refugee status, or seeking asylum.

Eligible participants could receive up to \$400 in compensation.

Consent must be provided by parents/guardians for participants under age 18.
