“Using Interfolio/Fac180 to Manage Your Faculty Profile/Activities: CVs, Scholarship Reporting, Evaluations, and Future Promotion”

Objectives:

At the end of this presentation, faculty should have increased information to 1) discuss the School of Medicine’s Interfolio (Fac180) platform and its uses by the administration and 2) explain where/how to log-in, search for and accept imported data, manually enter data, and maintain their records of activities for use in producing CVs, UT Tyler’s annual scholarship magazine, annual faculty evaluations, and future promotion dossiers.

Note: this system is only accessible to employed faculty of the UT Tyler School of Medicine.
