Distinguished Nursing Professor at UT Tyler. Prior, she served as Dean of Professional Studies & Chair of Nursing at East Texas Baptist University. As Director of EBP at Arizona State University, she led a team of EBP experts in writing the widely acclaimed "EBP Step-by-Step Series" in the *American Journal of Nursing*.



Bernadette Mazurek Melnyk, PhD, RN, CPNP/PMHNP, FAANP, FNAP, FAAN Currently the Associate Vice President

for Health Promotion, University Chief Wellness Officer, and Professor and Dean of the College of Nursing at The Ohio State University. Dr. Melnyk has

consulted with hundreds of healthcare systems and colleges throughout the nation and globe on how to improve quality of care and patient outcomes through implementing and sustaing evidence-based practice. Her record includes over 19 million dollars of sponsored funding from federal agencies as principal investigator and over 250 publications
