- Introductory Psychology
- Chemistry -or- Introduction to Ethics

*\*\*If you started at UT Tyler as a Freshman in Fall 2024 or Spring 2025 and you are ready to apply to the campus placement prior to Fall 2026, please see your academic advisor for guidance.*

## Requirements to Apply for Campus Placement

- Minimum of 3.0 GPA in all core courses and nursing prerequisite courses
- Minimum grade of 'C' in all nursing pre-requisite courses
- Completed TEAS Test (minimum score of 58.7)
