the research team, led by Dr. Belinda Deal, selected a random sample of people with diabetes mellitus, type 2 who were placed randomly in 4 groups. The intervention being tested was Motivational interviewing. The purpose of the intervention is to increase patient success in control of diabetes determined by the measurement of certain clinical outcomes. The data collected is currently being analyzed and the plan is to apply for a grant to include more participants and a more rigorous research design.
