



Coordinated Admissions Program (CAP) Contract at The University of Texas at Tyler

Please Read Carefully

CAP Requirements

Those who complete their CAP agreement and enroll in CAP must meet the following requirements to successfully complete the CAP program and to be offered automatic admission to UT Austin:

- Complete at least 30 semester credit hours of CAP approved coursework at your selected CAP institution.
- None of the individual grades you obtain for your transferable CAP courses can be below a C.
- The 30 hours of coursework must include at least one mathematics course beyond College Algebra from the CAP approved course list.
- Attain at least a 3.20 cumulative GPA on their 30 hours of CAP approved coursework.
- UT Austin must receive an official transcript showing successful completion of all required coursework by the date indicated in their correspondence with you.
- Participants may take a maximum of 11 credit hours in the Fall 2023 semester. Students may choose to begin their UT Tyler coursework in Summer 2023 and complete a course over the Wintermester session to lessen the number of credit hours needed in Spring 2024 to reach 30 credit hours.

Returning to UT Austin

Participants do not need to reapply to UT Austin for the fall semester following their CAP year. Admission is automatic for those who successfully meet the program requirements. During the CAP year, UT Austin will follow up with each participant with details about how the return process works.

Students who successfully complete CAP are guaranteed admission into most majors at UT Austin's College of Liberal Arts. They may choose to compete for admissions into other majors, but they are not guaranteed admission into other colleges.

If a student does not complete the CAP requirements by the deadline stated on the agreement, the student will no longer be guaranteed admission to UT Austin. Such students may, however, apply for transfer admission, but the previous CAP offer will not be considered in the admission decision.

In addition to understanding the CAP requirements, by signing below I authorize The University of Texas at Tyler to submit Official Transcripts to The University of Texas at Austin on my behalf when deemed appropriate.

***Note, it is the responsibility of the student to visit the CAP website frequently and be aware of important deadlines and requirements for successful completion of the CAP.**
