



Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Mathematics Co-Requisite Exemption Contract

Requirements

The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requires students to be assessed in Reading, Writing and Mathematics before enrolling in a Texas public college or university. Texas Education Code 51.3062 provides institutions of higher education a means of determining students' readiness to enroll in entry-level course work. Prior to enrollment in college-level courses, each student must be assessed in each area. Students who do not achieve the required TSI College-ready scores in Mathematics will be required to enroll in the appropriate co-requisite courses: a developmental Math course (MATH 0303) and a college-level Math course (MATH 1332 - Math For Liberal Arts or MATH 1342 - Statistics I). The following is an approved exemption to co-requisite enrollment:

- **An ABE Diagnostic score on the TSI Math Assessment of 0-3**

Based on your current ABE Diagnostic score on the TSI Math Assessment you are eligible to waive enrollment in the college-level course, MATH 1332 or MATH 1342, as a co-requisite for the Fall 2023 semester. Upon successful completion of MATH 0303 students will be considered TSI Complete in Math and will be eligible to enroll in college-level math courses in Spring 2024. Students who do not pass the MATH 0303 course will remain TSI Liable in Math and must repeat MATH 0303 in the Spring 2024 semester. Please select your Math enrollment option for Fall 2023:

Potential Delays to Graduation

Please understand that students in certain majors must complete specific college-level math courses in the first semester in order to stay on track for a four-year graduation.
