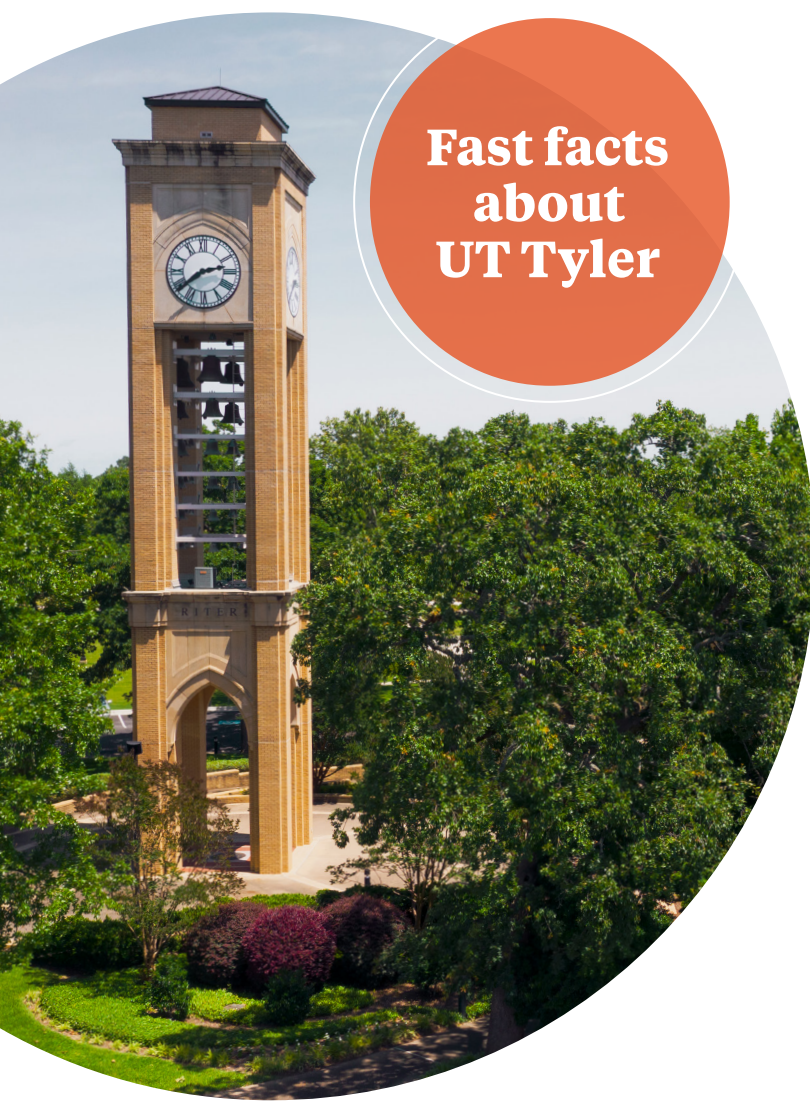

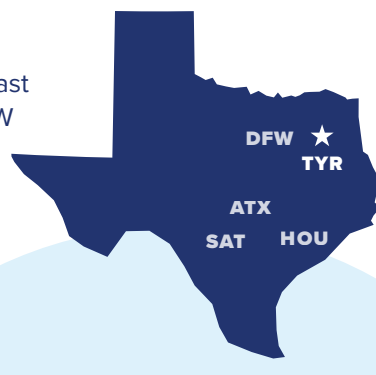

Admissions requirements

Whether you are a first-time freshman or transfer student, we want to ensure a smooth admissions process and get you on campus as soon as possible. Due to COVID-19, ACT or SAT test scores will not be required for the 2021–2022 academic year, but students are encouraged to send scores if they are available. Our admissions team is dedicated to making it easy for you and available to guide you through the process while answering any questions you may have.

FRESHMAN REQUIREMENTS

Top 25% automatically admitted

2nd–4th quartile minimum 2.75 GPA

TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

Credit Hours 30+
at accredited institution

GPA 2.0
on a 4.0 scale

Official Transcripts Provided from any institution attended

*If below 30 hours, must meet freshman admissions requirements.

Application process

Freshman

1. Fill out an International Undergraduate Freshman Application.
2. Pay the \$75 nonrefundable application fee.
3. Send your high school transcript
 - a. If your transcript is from an institution outside of the United States, you must provide an official transcript in your native language, and a translated copy showing high school completion.
 - b. For scholarship consideration, students must submit an evaluation with U.S. GPA equivalency.
4. Test Scores
 - a. Students must provide qualifying scores for one of the following English proficiency tests:
 - i. TOEFL: 79
 - ii. IELTS: 6.5
 - iii. Pearson: 53
 - iv. Duolingo English Test: 105
 - b. ACT or SAT
 - i. ACT or SAT test scores will not be required for the 2021–2022 academic year. Students are still encouraged to send scores if they are available.

Transfer

1. Fill out an International Undergraduate Transfer Application.
2. Pay the \$75 nonrefundable application fee.
3. Send your college or university transcripts
 - a. If your transcript is from an institution outside of the United States, you must provide an official transcript in your native language, and a translated course-by-course evaluation.
4. English Proficiency: students must provide one of the following:
 - a. Students must provide qualifying scores for one of the following English proficiency tests:
 - i. TOEFL: 79
 - ii. IELTS: 6.5
 - iii. Pearson: 53
 - iv. Duolingo English Test: 105
 - b. Students must make a B or higher in English Composition I and II at an American institution.

Scholarships

Both freshman and transfer international students can be eligible for academic competitive and merit scholarships through the Office of Admissions. International students that receive a competitive scholarship of \$1,000 or more are eligible to pay in-state tuition. Freshmen who are awarded a scholarship must confirm their attendance no later than May 1 to secure the award.

Freshman Competitive Awards

Scholarship recipients will be determined through a competitive process that places emphasis on the whole applicant, not just empirical data. Students must apply and provide official documents by the posted deadline date. Funding is limited. Students who are chosen to receive a competitive award will be contacted by email.

PRESIDENTIAL FELLOWSHIPS

UT Tyler awards full tuition, room and board, and books for a select group of high-achieving incoming freshmen with a GPA of 3.75 or higher. Apply by December 1.

PATRIOT SCHOLARSHIP

For first-time-in-college students who have at least a 3.5 GPA. Students can receive up to \$5,000, and the scholarship has four years of eligibility as long as renewal requirements are met. December 1 priority deadline, March 1 final deadline.

Freshman Academic Merit Awards

Scholarships are based solely on class rank and GPA.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP

For first-time-in-college students ranked in the top 25% of their high school class with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Students are awarded \$2,000 a year for four years.

Transfer Awards

TRANSFER PRESIDENTIAL

For students who have completed 30 college credit hours at time of admission and who have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. There is no scholarship application.
