Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits:

LSC transfer students that have followed and successfully completed the prescribed courses outlined in the 4-Year Suggested Academic Plan for Transfer will be guaranteed a seamless transfer of those courses from LSC to UT Tyler, regardless of modality or location of classes.

If a student completes all the courses in an FOSC and transfers to another Texas public institution of higher education, the FOSC courses transfer as a block and are applied to the student's selected major. If a student completes the FOSC, the Texas Core Curriculum, and any college or university courses required of all students regardless of major, the student is finished with all the lower-division courses. If a student transfers with an incomplete FOSC, each completed FOSC course transfers and applies to the degree program, and the institution may require the student to complete additional lower-division courses.
