COVID-19 hardships: Students can apply for federal assistance

UT Tyler students can now [apply](#) for a Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF II) grant to help with expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus, such as food, housing, course materials, technology, healthcare and child care expenses. The HEERF II funds are part of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) 2021.

Applications will be accepted [8 a.m. Monday, March 1 through Friday, March 19, 2021](#).

Qualifications (per the Department of Education and UT System):

- Students must be actively enrolled at UT Tyler for the current term of enrollment.
- Students with the highest financial need, such as Pell Grant recipients, will be prioritized for awards.
- Limited funds are available, so students are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. Funds will be awarded until UT Tyler's allocation is exhausted.
- Under current regulation, DACA and international students are not eligible for the HEERF funds.
