ACCREDITATION - PROVISIONAL IS AN ACCREDITATION STATUS GRANTED WHEN THE PLANS AND RESOURCE ALLOCATION, IF FULLY IMPLEMENTED AS PLANNED, OF A PROPOSED PROGRAM THAT HAS NOT YET ENROLLED STUDENTS APPEAR TO DEMONSTRATE THE PROGRAM'S ABILITY TO MEET THE ARC-PA STANDARDS OR WHEN A PROGRAM HOLDING ACCREDITATION-PROVISIONAL STATUS APPEARS TO DEMONSTRATE CONTINUED PROGRESS IN COMPLYING WITH THE STANDARDS AS IT PREPARES FOR THE GRADUATION OF THE FIRST CLASS (COHORT) OF STUDENTS.**
