NOMINATION MATERIALS REQUIRED

- 1. Letter of application (2 pages max) including the following:
 - a. teaching philosophy
 - b. why you believe your approach to education represents outstanding teaching
 - c. what you would like to contribute to the UT Tyler ADT
 - d. your contact information (name, phone number, office, & e-mail address)
- 2. Condensed curriculum vitae (4 pages max) noting:
 - a. places and dates served and serving as an educator
 - b. list of courses taught
 - c. scholarly work related to teaching and learning
 - d. teaching-related honors and awards
- 3. Summary of successful teaching activities, practices, or strategies (4 pages max) noting:
 - a. supporting evidence of innovative approaches to teaching and learning
 - supporting evidence of teaching excellence (which may include, but is not limited to, student evaluations, feedback from colleagues, influence on student success, impact of class-related activities on the community as you define it.)

SUBMISSION PROCESS

The nominee application packet must be <u>no longer than 10 pages</u> and compiled as a single PDF document bearing the nominee's first initial, last name, and membership year (e.g., JSmith2021.pdf).

To be considered for membership, please submit your complete application packet electronically to <u>academy@uttyler.edu</u> by the deadline outlined in the annual call sent electronically to faculty.

SELECTION PROCESS

Selection for membership is evaluated based on the criteria outlined in the NOMINATION MATERIALS REQUIRED section of the call. This Membership Committee reviews nominations and recommends up to two new Academy members annually.
