Walking Off-Sequence (Prior Commencement)

Commencement Participation: Students are **expected** to walk in the ceremony in the same semester/term in which they apply for graduation. Only under specific circumstances may a qualifies student request to walk in a commencement ceremony that is outside of their graduation term. To do so, they **must** meet the following qualifications:

- 1. <u>Undergraduates Students</u>: must be within 9 semester credit hours of degree completion.
- 2. **Graduate Students**: must be within 6 semester credit hours of degree completion.
 - a. The remaining coursework needed for completion MUST be completed within the following subsequent term.

- 5. Completed the Walking OFF Sequence Form **PRIOR** to the Commencement Registration Deadline for the term in which you want to attend. (Supporting documentation is required)
 - a. Please refer to the Commencement Student Checklist webpage for the deadline. (https://www.uttyler.edu/commencement/student-checklist/) This information will be updated each semester.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Please plan accordingly as the ceremonies are ticketed and tickets are limited. Missed deadlines may result in not being able to participate the desired commencement ceremony or may result in not being able to receive tickets for guests. **Participation in the commencement ceremony does not guarantee conferring of any degrees.**

Other Students Who May Qualify

- Active-duty military students that are being deployed.
- Reserved military student that are being activated.
- International students with personal or international guests that are having visa-related issues
- Students with extreme personal events:
 - o Death in immediate family.
 - o Birth of a child in immediate Family.
 - o Student or immediate family member that is required to be hospitalized.

Steps for Applying to Walk Off-Sequence

- 1. Ensure all qualifications are met.
- 2. Complete the Walking Off-Sequence Form (see below) by the required deadline.
- 3. Submit supporting documentation to <u>graduation@uttyler.edu</u> by the required deadline. Supporting documents may include one or more of the following:
 - a. If walking semester prior to graduation...
 - i. Proof of graduation application submitted for appropriate term.
 - ii. Proof of course registration in subsequent term.
 - b. Other possible supporting documentation...
 - i. Proof of military deployment/activation.
 - ii. Documentation of International visa issues.
 - iii. Documentation of family emergency Issues.
- 4. The Office of the Registrar will submit the official request to the College/School Dean for approval with the completed form and supporting documentation.
- 5. The College/School Dean approval must be submitted directly from the department to graduation@uttyler.edu.
 - a. NOTE: This cannot be submitted by the student.
