

Student Exposure to COVID-19

Have you had close contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19?

Close contact means:

- Living in the same house or residence hall room as someone with Covid-19.
- Caring for someone with COVID-19.
- Having been within 6 feet of someone with COVID-19 for 15 minutes or longer.
- Having been in direct contact with secretions from someone with COVID-19.

IF YES:

- Contact the UT Tyler COVID Hotline, 903.565.5999, immediately.
- Stay home for 14 days from the time of your exposure. Do not go to class or come to campus.
- Avoid contact with others.
- Take your temperature two times a day to monitor for fever and record your results.
- Watch for cough, trouble breathing or other COVID-19 symptoms.
- Review the COVID-19 daily health assessment on uttyler.edu/coronavirus and follow the instructions based on symptoms.
- Do not take any form of public transportation, taxis or ride-shares.
- A UT Tyler COVID coordinator will work with you throughout your quarantine to provide support services.
 - Communication with your professors.
 - Logistical support for remote coursework.
 - Meal and laundry options.
 - Mental and physical health resources.
 - Communication with the Offices of Student Success and Residence Life.
