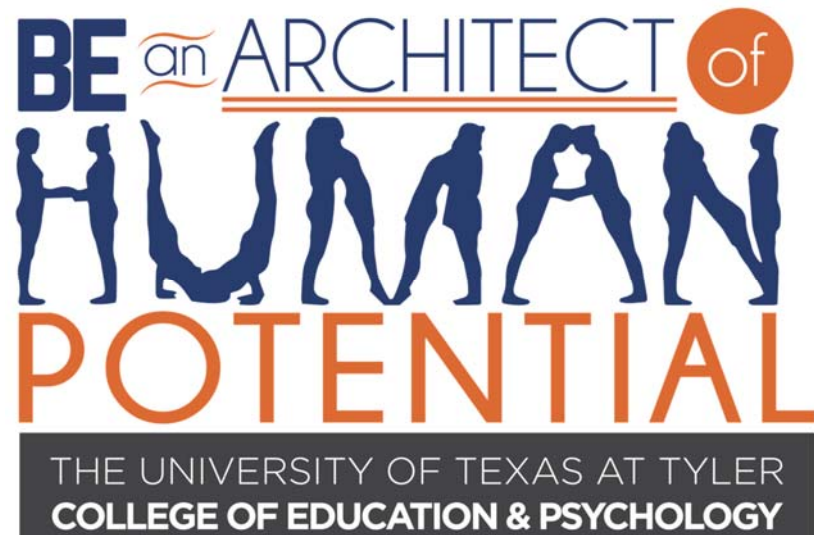

- Possess a teaching certification (in any field)
- Submit GRE scores (UT Tyler code is 6850)
- Applicants with a GPA of 3.25 or better on your last 60-hours of coursework or overall GPA do not need to submit GRE
