- 12:35 Welcome and Call to Order/Invocation Dr. Harrison Ndetan, Faculty Senate President 12:37 Approval of January minutes Dr. Julie George, Faculty Senate Secretary
- 12:38 President Update Dr. Kirk Calhoun
 - In process of presenting Presidential Scholarships to area students (\$40K 4-year scholarship)
 - Working on updating website: surveys are coming and faculty one was sent already; working with consultant on full website redesign
 - Legislature Updates:
 - Have been before the Senate Finances committee and will be with the House Appropriations committee soon to discuss the upcoming budget; then the dual committee from both houses will meet and determine final budget to send back to the House and Senate for approval before going to the Governor
 - o Resources are better coming out of COVID
 - o Asking for a major investment in higher education
 - Social issues (i.e. critical race theory, diversity, equity, inclusion) are being discussed in legislative sessions; will update on new bills as needed
 - Question: What about tuition increase? -We'll wait and see what the budget ends up looking like; if we get the funding, tuition won't increase, but if not we may need to go to the Board of Regents in their August meeting to discuss
 - Question: Is there a plan for the 4th floor of the Soules COB? -nothing currently; right now the building focus on campus is the SON building and the new science building, and plans for it are moving along

12:54 EVP Health Affairs Update: Dr. Julie Philley

- SOM ground breaking was in January with an expected completion date in 2025
- Have reviewed over 2000 applications for the first medical school cohort of 40 students; 30+ offers have been made but will know the full cohort after March 1
- Currently have 150 residents but working to open more fellowships for med students
- UT Health hospital and clinics were able to meet budget, which is a difficult thing to do right now
- New deans for COP and SHP starting in March
- Final rendition for SON building is going before the Board of Regents next week
- New nursing programs are in the works
- Question: Do we have the space for med students since the building won't be complete until 2025? -Yes, they will be housed at the North campus for now and renovations are being done to accommodate.
- 12:59 Research/Scholarship and Graduate School Update: Drs. Steve Idell and Kouider Mokhtari
 - Research must be impactful, goal is not just to get more funding

- Need mentors to guide new faculty in their research and each college/department should have dedicated conversations about how to achieve this
- UG research experiences are low but we are looking at ways to improve that
- RCR-responsible research training should be done by all faculty and any students who will be assisting

1:07 2023 Academic Administrators Evaluation Protocol: Dr. Lou Ann Berman

- Clarification of Administration Evaluation:
 - Evaluation of Interim Appointees: evaluate after at least 1 full semester of service and currently serving in role at time of eval
 - Department Chair evaluation reports for chairs with fewer than 5 full-time faculty: only aggregate scores will be provided to the individual (comments to the Dean, Provost, and HR) to ensure protection of anonymity
- Survey dates: 3/30-4/13
- Contact Lou Ann for specific protocol questions

1:12 End of Course Evaluations-Pilot Study: Drs. Josh Banta and Chris Thomas

- Integrated to single set of questions for both campuses
- Task force included faculty, staff, and students
- Goal: concise, unbiased survey
- New survey developed with 4 questions
- Fall pilot:
 - Legacy questions and new questions were combined
 - o New questions were not used for evaluation purposes; data only
 - o Extended survey window through finals week
- Analysis:
 - Both legacy and new questions were determined to be internally consistent and could measure overall teaching effectiveness
 - o Extending the end date found no overall meaningful difference in scores; compared those who completed before finals and those done in finals week
 - o New questions had slightly lower scores than the legacy items, but the effect was small
 - No bias indicated and no major change or differences found between legacy and new questions
 - o Propose to keep legacy questions to be able to compare to past evaluations
