

Panola County Economic Overview

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Demographic Profile

The population in Panola County, Texas was 23,186 per American Community Survey data for 2016-2020. The region has a civilian labor force of 9,623 with a participation rate of 52.4%. Of individuals 25 to 64 in Panola County, Texas, 17.3% have a bachelor's degree or higher which compares with 34.3% in the nation. The median household income in Panola County, Texas is \$51,297 and the median house value is \$117,000.



Unemployment Rate


The unemployment rate for Panola County, Texas was 4.4% as of October 2022. The regional unemployment rate was higher than the national rate of 3.4%. One year earlier, in October 2021, the unemployment rate in Panola County, Texas was 5.7%.



Unemployment rate data are from the Local Area Unemployment Statistics, provided by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and updated through October 2022.

Wage Trends

The average worker in Panola County, Texas earned annual wages of \$49,184 as of 2022Q2. Average annual wages per worker increased 9.5% in the region over the preceding four quarters. For comparison purposes, annual average wages were \$67,777 in the nation as of 2022Q2.



Annual average wages per worker data are derived from the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages, provided by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and imputed where necessary. Data are updated through 2022Q1 with preliminary estimates updated to 2022Q2.

About This Report

Cost of Living Index

The Cost of Living Index estimates the relative price levels for consumer goods and services. When applied to wages and salaries, the result is a measure of relative purchasing power. The cost of living is 10.2% lower in Panola County, Texas than the U.S. average.

Occupation Snapshot

The largest major occupation group in Panola County, Texas is Construction and Extraction Occupations, employing 1,174 workers. The next-largest occupation groups in the region are Management Occupations (915 workers) and Office and Administrative Support Occupations (881). High location quotients (LQs) indicate occupation groups in which a region has high concentrations of employment compared to the national average. The major groups with the largest LQs in the region are Construction and Extraction Occupations (LQ = 2.81), Building and Grounds Cleaning and Maintenance Occupations (1.73), and Installation, Maintenance, and Repair Occupations (1.46).

Occupation groups in Panola County, Texas with the highest average wages per worker are Legal Occupations (\$91,200), Architecture and Engineering Occupations (\$83,300), and Management Occupations (\$80,600). The unemployment rate in the region varied among the major groups from 1.8% among Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations to 9.2% among Construction and Extraction Occupations.

Over the next 1 year, the fastest growing occupation group in Panola County, Texas is expected to be Food Preparation and Serving Related Occupations with a +0.8% year-over-year rate of growth. The strongest forecast by number of jobs over this period is expected for Food Preparation and Serving Related Occupations (+3 jobs) and Construction and Extraction Occupations (+2). Over the same period, the highest separation demand (occupation demand due to retirements and workers moving from one occupation to another) is expected in Construction and Extraction Occupations (121 jobs) and Sales and Related Occupations (101).

Occupation employment data are estimated via industry employment data and the estimated industry/occupation mix. Industry employment data are derived from the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages, provided by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and currently updated through 2022Q1, imputed where necessary with preliminary estimates updated to 2022Q2. Wages by occupation are as of 2021 provided by the BLS and imputed where necessary. Forecast employment growth uses national projections from the Bureau of Labor Statistics adapted for regional growth patterns.



Industry Clusters

A cluster is a geographic concentration of interrelated industries or occupations. The industry cluster in Panola County, Texas with the highest relative concentration is Coal/Oil/Power with a location quotient of 13.06. This cluster employs 947 workers in the region with an average wage of \$79,287. Employment in the Coal/Oil/Power cluster is projected to expand in the region about 1.3% per year over the next ten years.


Industry Clusters for Panola County, Texas as of 2022Q2



Education Levels

Expected growth rates for occupations vary by the education and training required. While all employment in Panola County, Texas is projected to contract 0.4% over the next ten years, occupations typically requiring a postgraduate degree are expected to contract 0.7% per year, those requiring a bachelor's degree are forecast to contract 0.2% per year, and occupations typically needing a 2-year degree or certificate are expected to contract 0.0% per year.

Gross Domestic Product


Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is the total value of goods and services produced by a region. In 2021, nominal GDP in Panola County, Texas expanded 11.4%. This follows a contraction of 25.7% in 2020. As of 2021, total GDP in Panola County, Texas was \$898,225,000.

Of the sectors in Panola County, Texas, Construction contributed the largest portion of GDP in 2021, \$126,354,000 The next-largest contributions came from Mining, Quarrying, and Oil and Gas Extraction (\$101,163,000); Manufacturing (\$100,502,000); and Wholesale Trade (\$88,647,000).
