Evaluation

Please keep in mind, as a zero-credit course, no credit hours are earned. **In order to receive the grade of CR for this course, students cannot miss more than one class meeting.** If you must miss more than one meeting, you must set up a time to meet with me outside of class. Additionally, students must earn a satisfactory evaluation on the following assignments:

- Seminar Attendance
- Submission of Contract Course Proposal (3000) or Senior Research Project Proposal (4000)
- Completion of Contract Coursework and approval from faculty mentor (3000)
- Faculty approval of Senior Research Project progress (4000)
- Participation in Honors Events

Students who do not earn a grade of CR in an Honors Seminar will lose good standing in the Honors Program.
