HNRS 3000.060—Honors Junior Seminar

HNRS 3000 is a zero-credit course that is required for participation in the Honors Program. This course is designed to allow students to get the most out of their experience in the Honors Program during their time at UT Tyler. HNRS 3000 will focus on content related to the research track, service track, and leadership track. Additionally, students will be required to attend all Honors Colloquium events during the semester in which they are enrolled in the class. This course is designed to be taken twice and in sequence, beginning in the fall semester.

Student Learning Outcomes

- Students will learn about and discuss issues in academic research.
- Students will attend Honors colloquium events.
 - Students will review preparatory material for all colloquium events.
 - Students will participate in a seminar-style discussion about the topics and issues covered in colloquium events.

Students will receive a grade of either "CR" (credit) or "NC" (no credit) for this course. Please keep in mind, as a zero-credit course, no credit hours are earned. In order to receive the grade of CR for this course, students cannot miss more than two class meetings. Additionally, students must earn a satisfactory evaluation on the following assignments:

- Canvas Participation (turning in paperwork for contract courses, meetings for service or leadership tracks, etc.)

Students will earn a satisfactory evaluation by preparing and fully participating in the aforementioned assignments. Students who do not earn a grade of CR in an Honors Seminar will lose good standing in the Honors Program.
