## Workers' Compensation Injury Process & Procedure

- 1. Notify your supervisor immediately of the incident, no matter how minor the injury may seem. If necessary, please report unsafe working conditions to your supervisor or the Environmental Health & Safety Department at (903) 566-7011.
- 2. Please also notify Environmental Health and Safety, (903) 566-7011, of the incident and fill out the necessary paperwork. This includes the Employee's First Report of a Work-Related Injury or Occupational Disease form and WC Network Acknowledgement Form. Please note that failure to notify within 30 days may result in denial of the claim.
- If necessary, please obtain medical attention. UT System has contracted with <u>IMO Med-Select Network</u> to assist employees with obtaining appropriate medical treatment for work-related injuries. To find an in-network provider within this network, please go to the <u>IMO Find a Provider Search</u>.
- 4. Environmental Health and Safety will provide you with a **Notification of On-The-Job Injury form** to give to your medical provider. This form will notify the provider that the injury is work- related and where to submit any bills, medical reports or questions regarding your claim.
- 5. If you miss work due to an on the job injury, you must keep your supervisor and Environmental Health and Safety informed of your work status by providing a Division of Workers' Compensation Work Status Report (**DWC 73**) after each doctor visit. The doctor's office must provide this report to the injured employee.
- 6. If you are out due to your injury for more than one day, you must also complete the **Request for Paid Leave** form to select the type of leave you wish to utilize for your absence.
- 7. When your doctor releases you to return to work, a Work Status Form (**DWC 73**) from your doctor indicating a return to work date or any work-related limitations must be given to your supervisor before you may return.
