- ¹³ The completion of this degree does not by itself satisfy the requirements of the Music All-Level (Grades EC-12) Specialization Certificate in the state of Texas. Additional coursework includes 15 hours of professional development courses (EDUC 3315, EPSY 3340, EDSP 3351, EDUC 4320, and EDFB 4338), six hours of Clinical Teaching (EDUC 4640), and the Clinical Teaching Seminar (EDUC 4057). Students wishing to pursue this certification should plan on the degree taking 9 or more semesters, entering with advanced placement / transfer credits, enrolling in more than 16 credits in some semesters, and/or taking some courses (usually Core) during Summer terms.
