Course Requirements

- Each student must have her/his own instrument, footstool/guitar support, pencil, nail care items, and music at every rehearsal.
- Students are required to mark their music as necessary and as assigned.
- Students are required to prepare their assigned parts outside of rehearsal time.

Course Objectives

- To make high quality, expressive music at each rehearsal and performance.
- To perform as a group and/or as small groups both on and off campus.
- To be a representative group for the guitar program and the music department as a whole.

Grading Procedures

Rehearsal Attendance and Preparation: 40%
Performance Attendance: 40%
Oral and Written Assignments: 20%

Attendance Policy

Students are allowed to miss one rehearsal per semester. For each additional missed rehearsal, the student's grade will be dropped by one letter grade (i.e. 2 rehearsals = B, 3 missed rehearsals = C, etc.). Absences must be cleared by the Instructor to be excused. In the event of an emergency, sudden sickness, etc., please email or call as soon as is possible.

Oral/Written Assignments

From time to time, you may be asked to prepare a brief oral presentation to the group or to write a descriptive assignment. For written assignments, one FULL page, double-spaced, 12 pt font, Times New Roman, will suffice. For oral presentations, please be prepared to discuss the topic and answer additional questions.
