The Nursing Informatics, Quality & Safety MSN program prepares the bachelors prepared registered nurse to integrate nursing science with multiple information management and analytical sciences to identify, define, manage, and communicate data, information, knowledge, and wisdom in nursing practice. This MSN program meets the education requirement for the American Nurses Credentialing Center's (ANCC) Informatics Nursing Certification exam. Approved by The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board. This program will be available pending approval by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges.

Objectives: At the completion of the Nursing Informatics, Quality & Safety MSN Program, the graduate will be able to: 1) utilize essential knowledge and skills required in the role of the informatics nurse; 2) be qualified for an entry-level informatics nursing position.

The Master of Science in Nursing program builds on UT Tyler's undergraduate program in nursing and provides a firm basis for doctoral-level education.
