**Post Bachelor's Nursing Informatics, Quality & Safety Certificate Program**

The Nursing Informatics, Quality & Safety Certificate program prepares the bachelor's-prepared registered nurse to integrate nursing science with multiple information management and analytical sciences to identify, define, manage, and communicate data, information, knowledge, and wisdom in nursing practice.

This certificate program meets the education requirement for the American Nurses Credentialing Center's (ANCC) Informatics Nursing Certification exam.

**Objectives**

At the completion of the Nursing Informatics, Quality & Safety Certificate Program, the graduate will be able to: 1) utilize essential knowledge and skills required in the role of the informatics nurse; 2) be qualified for an entry level informatics nursing position.

**Completion of the Certificate**

The successful completion of 15 semester credit hours is required to complete the certificate program (see courses listed below). These courses will be listed on an official university transcript and a certificate of completion will be awarded.
