

UT Tyler COVID-19 Weekly Update - April 24

DOE releases updated CARES grant eligibility requirements

The US Department of Education has released more specific guidance on how UT Tyler may distribute the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act grants to students. The new guidelines prohibit distribution of the CARES Act grant to students enrolled in completely online programs at the time UT Tyler moved its in-person classes to an online format. The grants are specifically for expenses incurred as a result of disruption to the education process created by the COVID-19 pandemic. *CARES funds have not been received by UT Tyler yet, but they are expected to be released shortly. When they are, all students will be emailed a link to the grant application.*

UT Tyler University Pines residents released from leases

UT Tyler and CLV (the private company that operates University Pines) have reached an agreement in favor of UT Tyler students. Under the terms of the agreement, UT Tyler students residing at University Pines this semester will not be financially liable for terminating leases early due to COVID-19 guidance. Students who moved out on March 16 or later and have already paid for the time period beyond their move-out date will be reimbursed by CLV.
