



THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT TYLER FOOD SAFETY PROGRAM

General:

- All food served or delivered to campus shall comply with all applicable NET Health regulations which can be found on the NET Health website: <https://www.mynethealth.org/>
- Any food served or delivered to campus must come from a NET Health permitted vendor. A current list of vetted food vendors can be found here: <https://www.uttyler.edu/event-management/food-vendors/>
- Vendors bringing food from outside of Smith County will have to obtain a NET Health Temporary Food Establishment Permit prior to serving any food on campus.
- Potlucks are allowed on campus provided they are closed events and attendees are strictly limited to members of a single organization or single department. Potlucks cannot be open to the campus community, student body, or members of the public.
- Bake Sales are not permitted on campus unless they comply with the Cottage Food Law, information on compliance can be found here: <https://texascottagefoodlaw.com/>
- Any events held on campus that will be open to the entire campus community or public and will serve food should be coordinated through NET Health with the use of their “Coordinator Application for a Single Event or Celebration”
- The Department of Environmental Health and Safety is the on-campus authority for all matters of food safety.
 - NET Health permits for all food vendors must be submitted to EH&S prior to providing food on the UT Tyler campus.
