A student may not audit a course offered on an individual instruction basis, a course requiring the use of laboratories, computer or studios, receive credit for the course, nor be eligible for advanced standing examination. Participation in class activities is at the discretion of the instructor.
- 3. **Social Security Number**: Disclosure of your Social Security Number ("SSN") is requested for the student records system of The University of Texas at Tyler (the "University") and for compliance with Federal and State reporting requirements. Federal law requires that you provide your SSN if you are applying for financial aid. Although a SSN is not required for admission to the University, failure to provide your SSN may result in delays in processing your application or in the University's inability to match your application with transcripts, test scores, and other materials.
