

Creating Workflows - Terms

- Workflows: Allow you to trigger tasks based on various events.
 For both the inciting event and the resulting task, you have a lot of options, most of which are inside the Qualtrics platform and some of which are outside.
 - An EVENT starts a workflow
 - CONDITIONS use logic to decide when workflows are triggered (begin)
 - TASKS are the outcomes that are triggers in response to the event and/or conditions being met
