- Overview of the updated Strategic Plan and Campus Master Plan:
 - New Strategic Priorities:
 - ♦ Student Success
 - ♦ Teaching Excellence

- ♦ Service to East Texas
- Reduced focus on growth metrics (enrollment, research volume); increased focus on quality and impact.
- Strategic planning now includes:
 - Enhanced student services
 - Greater campus accessibility (e.g., proposed pedestrian bridge)
 - Revised campus layout to foster connection and ease of access
- Master Plan Highlights:
 - New residence hall, redesigned academic spaces, and retention pond for improved stormwater management.
 - Improved pedestrian paths and looped access routes.
- Design thinking approach to improve operational areas, starting with procurement and onboarding.
- Q: Statement recommending planning to have a state of the university event for the fall, where you invite the community to the campus and communicate what's happening at UT Tyler and the future of the University, such as the new plan.
- Q: How will the new developments be funded?
 - Long-term projects to be funded through various sources, including grants, philanthropy, and Board of Regents approvals.
- Q: If you had to guess what's "long term" mean? As a R2 school we need more lab space to keep competitive with others when it comes to getting grants.
 - There are short- and long-term goals. It will be a number of years before some of these projects would break ground. Specifically to research, there will be a lot of redesigning. Many issues are space utilization rather than square footage.
