- 4th: Registration for Spring 2022 begins for freshmen (0-30 hours) <u>AND Career Success</u> <u>Conference</u> (12 pm to 6:30 pm)
- 5th: Last day to schedule thesis or dissertation defense for Fall 2021 Graduation

NOVEMBER 12TH

• Last day to withdraw from one or more courses for Second 7-Week Session

NOVEMBER 15TH

- Priority Filing Date for Spring 2022 Graduation
- Payment due date for last installment if you have taken out an installment plan!

NOVEMBER 19TH

• Last day to submit completed thesis or dissertation for Fall 2021 Graduation

NOVEMBER 22ND – 27TH

- 22nd 27th: Thanksgiving holidays for faculty and students
- 25th 26th: Thanksgiving holidays for staff, all offices closed

NOVEMBER 30TH

• Final grade rosters open for Second 7-Week Session

myUTTyler: By now you should have an idea of your grades in each course. MyUTTyler has many advising and academic resources that you can access to ensure you stay on track for graduation, explore different degree requirements, and earn the grades you need to make the GPA you are working toward! SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION (SI)

• <u>SI</u> is a series of weekly peer-assisted study sessions in courses identified by previous students as difficult.

UPSWING

 <u>(24/7 Online Tutoring) Upswing</u> is a free, confidential, and convenient way to receive help in nearly all of UT Tyler's undergraduate courses. Use your UT Tyler credentials to log in to this resource.

THE WRITING CENTER

• <u>The Writing Center</u> provides all undergraduate and graduate students a place to work on their writing projects and skills. There are tutoring options as well as workshops available to support you in your academic writing.

MATH LEARNING CENTER

• <u>The Math Learning Center</u> provides drop-in tutoring for lower-level math courses throughout the week. The MLC also has computer workstations for your use.
